Coach	<p>⇒ Free entry for 1 coach per 5 competitors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - From 1 to 5 competitors: 1 coach - From 6 to 10 competitors: 2 coaches - De 11 à 15 compétiteurs : 3 coaches - From 11 to 15 competitors: 3 coaches - ... <p>⇒ Each additional coach must pay €10.</p>
Conditions	<p>⇒ The organizer cannot be held responsible if an athlete ends up alone in their category.</p> <p>⇒ No refund shall be made.</p>
Spectators	<p>⇒ €10 / person (we accept payments by card)</p> <p>⇒ Free for children under 6 years old.</p>
Weigh-in	<p>⇒ Each competitor must present their license with a photo and their ID card at the weigh-in.</p> <p><u>Seniors and Masters</u></p> <p>Senior and master competitors must present themselves alone at the weigh-in.</p> <p>A tolerance of 99 g is allowed at the weigh-in.</p> <p><u>Examples:</u></p> <p>A competitor weighing 58.0 kg is in the –58 kg category.</p> <p>A competitor weighing 58.1 kg is in the –63 kg category.</p> <p><u>Pupils, minors, cadets and juniors</u></p> <p>⇒ Coaches are allowed to accompany pupils, minors, cadets and juniors during the weigh-in.</p> <p>⇒ As weighing in naked is not permitted for these age groups, an excess of up to 199 g is tolerated.</p>

Category change	<p><u>Paid</u></p> <p>⇒ After the registration deadline, in case of overweight or incorrect registration, category changes are only allowed during weigh-in and are subject to a fee.</p> <p>Each category change costs €15, to be paid at the registration desk.</p> <p>⇒ Upon presentation of the payment proof (receipt), the Martial.Events will issue a new competitor card to the coach. The competitor will be automatically placed in the new category and does not need to weigh in again.</p> <p><u>Free</u></p> <p>⇒ If they are alone in their weight category, pupils, minimes, cadets, juniors, seniors and masters may move up by one weight category only. This request must be made exclusively by the coach to the Martial.Events staff.</p> <p><u>Not allowed</u></p> <p>⇒ Neither at the time of registration nor on the day of the event:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No competitor is allowed to move up or down in age category. • No C-class competitor is allowed to move up or down in grade category. • No A/B-class competitor is allowed to move down in grade category.

Fight duration	<p>Best of 3 rounds</p> <p>Pupils: 3 x 1 minute (60-second break)</p> <p>Minors : 3 x 1 minute (60-second break)</p> <p>Cadets C : 3 x 1,5 minute (60-second break)</p> <p>Cadets AB : 3 x 1,5 minute (60-second break)</p> <p>Juniors : 3 x 1,5 minute (60-second break)</p> <p>Seniors : 3 x 2 minutes (60-second break)</p> <p>Masters : 3 x 2 minutes (60-second break)</p> <p><i>Note:</i> Depending on how the competition unfolds, these times may be adjusted by the competition's technical delegate.</p>
Area of competition	8 octagonal-shaped areas

E-trunk	<p>⇒ The competition will use Daedo GEN 2 electronic body protectors for all categories, and electronic headgear for categories where head kicks are allowed.</p> <p>⇒ Each competitor must bring their own Daedo electronic socks (foot protectors).</p> <p>⇒ Competitors who do not kick to the head must bring their own headgear.</p>
Video replay	Video replay only for all AB categories.
Referees	National and international referees (IR – WT)
Individual rewards	<p>⇒ 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each category will receive a gold, silver, and bronze medal respectively.</p> <p>⇒ Medals will be awarded at the end of each fight.</p> <p>⇒ Two cups will be awarded:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fair-play cup • La coupe du (de la) meilleur(e) arbitre
Team rewards	<p>⇒ A trophy will be awarded to the first 3 teams.</p> <p>⇒ For the final team ranking, points will be allocated according to the World Taekwondo competition rules.</p>

Protest	Only the head coach is allowed to file a protest, and it must be done immediately after the end of the match. They must complete the official protest form provided by the organizer. A fee of €100 must be paid for each protest. This amount will be refunded only if the protest is upheld. The decision of the Technical Delegate is final and binding. INSURANCE AND SECURITY

Competitors	⇒ Each competitor must hold a valid license for the ongoing year. ⇒ Competitors must carry their ID or passport. ⇒ Each competitor takes part in this competition at their own risk. ⇒ The organizers and the ABFT decline all responsibility in case of physical harm, acts of violence, injuries and theft.
Head strikes	⇒ Head kicks are forbidden for all pupils, all minors and for C cadets. ⇒ Head kicks are allowed from AB cadets onwards, as well as for all juniors.
Coach	⇒ The coach must be over 18 years old.

	<p>⇒ They must wear sports clothing (tracksuit and trainers) while coaching.</p> <p>⇒ They must carry their ID or passport.</p> <p>⇒ Coaches from a federation that is a member of the BTF (ABFT – TKDV – TVDSG) must hold a national or WT coach card.</p> <p>⇒ The coach must hold a valid license-insurance for the ongoing year.</p>
Guards	<p>⇒ All protections required by the WT regulations are mandatory for all categories (headgear, mouthguard, forearm guards, gloves, groin guard, shin guard, and electronic socks), even for the categories where head contact is forbidden.</p> <p>⇒ The face shield is allowed but not mandatory for all beginners, minors and cadets.</p>
First aid	A doctor will be present throughout the competition.

FACILITIES

Accessibility The sports hall is located 1,5 km away from the E19, exit “Lennik ULB Erasme”.

Parking Free parking spaces are available in the immediate surroundings of the sports hall.

Food ⇒ The organizer will sell snacks and light meals.
