

INFORMATION TO UNVACCINATED DELEGATION MEMBERS AND PLAYERS FROM EUROPEAN UNION AND COUNTRIES OUTSIDE EUROPEAN UNION ABOVE 12 YEARS OLD

According to the regulations from The Government of the Republic of Estonia persons who are not vaccinated/who have not previously been infected, citizens of countries where 14-day infection rate > 200.1 new cases per 100,000 people per day have to fulfill a 10-day self-isolation requirement (on their own expense) what may be shortened by taking a test upon arrival and a second test what is required not earlier than the sixth day after the first negative test.

There must be at least 6 days between the two tests to shorten the self-isolation period. If the first test was taken before arriving in Estonia (up to 72 hours before arrival), the second test can be taken on the third day after arrival at the earliest.

Organizing committee has a special permission from the Estonian Health Department to organize Kids and Cadets European Championships, Open Under 21 European Championships, in August according to the special Covid-19 regulations and rules.

Special permission allows to the unvaccinated delegation members **who are living in official hotel booked via OC**, (what includes: transfer buses, extra disinfection, random rapid-testing etc) **not to fulfill self-isolation** but to enter the venue and compete, by making two Covid-19 tests.

- Unvaccinated athletes and delegation members above 12 years old from countries outside European Union and "red" European Union countries – must take the test either 48 (antigen) or max 72 hours before (PCR) entering the country and PCR test upon arrival to Estonia – and the result of this test must be negative (**special price for PCR test is provided by OC** – testing in hotel will be 50 euro per person).

INFORMATION TO VACCINATED PARTICIPANTS AND DELEGATION MEMBERS

Please, be informed that all delegation members may be a subject of random testing (vaccinated and unvaccinated members). During your stay it maybe be more than one test. For the delegation members staying in official hotel booked via OC – daily rapid testing is included in the price – you will not need to pay for rapid tests.

PARENTS

Due to the new regulations we inform you, that not only players but also parents from abroad who bring their kids to the tournaments will have a separate accreditation to enter the venue.

In order to get a "supporter" accreditation for the European championships – during the registration parent should show the OC one of this three documents:

- 1) PCR test made not more then 72h before arrival to Estonia; or
- 2) Vaccination certification/pass/proof; or
- 3) Certificate of recovery from COVID-19 (not older than 180 days).

*Additionally, all delegations members should live in OC hotel.
