5. METHODS OF COMPETITION

- The best of three (3) system - Men's / Women's : (Respectively) Single elimination tournament system for each weight category.
- Each match allows for one video replay request
- All competitors must wear WT
- approved competition uniform and protective equipment.
- Senior division seeded according to the published November 1 st 2026 World Taekwondo rankings.

30% of contestants shall be seeded.

(Changed during Head of team meeting at the discretion of the TD.)

- KPNP (K2) or (K1) Protector and Scoring System (PSS) will be used in Kyorugi competition. The Organizing Committee will provide KPNP (K2) (K1) Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.

6. COMPETITION RULES

- Latest WT Competition Rules shall be applied.

7. DURATION OF COMPETITION

- Under 7&9 :1minute x 3rounds (30 seconds breaktime)
- Under 10&11 :1minute x 3rounds (30 seconds breaktime)
- Cadet :1 minute 30 seconds x 3rounds (30 seconds breaktime)
- Junior :1 minute 30 seconds x 3 rounds (30 seconds breaktime)
- Senior :2 minutex 3 rounds (1 minute break time)

8. WEIGH-IN

- General Weigh-in for the contestants shall be completed one day before their scheduled competition day.
- Weigh-in shall be made once, however, in case of under or exceeding, one more chance will be given within the weigh-in time. (approximately two hours)
- All contestants should bring their AD cards when they weigh-in, otherwise

disqualification.

- The random weigh-in will take place at the venue in the morning of the competition. All contestants who pass the general weigh-in must be present for random weigh-in maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition. Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh-in, he/she will be disqualified. The random weigh-in must be completed maximum thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition each day.
- The list of athletes selected for the random weigh-in will be announced on the O.C Website on the morning of the competition day.

It may be subject to change at the discretion of the TD during the head of the team meeting.

Weight Change Policy

A **USD 15 fee** will be charged for any weight-category change.

Weight changes may be requested **only at the time of ID pick-up**. Once the weight category has been changed, **no further changes will be permitted**.

All participants are requested to carefully confirm their final weight category before completing the change.

2. OTHERS

A. The above information is subject to change upon the decision made at the Head of Team Meeting.

B. All officials, including the Head of Team and coaches of each participating team, must complete the official registration and obtain an AD Card to access the stadium. All coaches must complete the WT Coach Certification Course in Level 1.

C. If a competitor is called three (3) times, starting 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the match, and fails to participate after confirming their participation, the competitor will be disqualified.

D. Any matters not specified in these regulations shall be decided by the Organizing Committee of the **Uzbekistan Open International Taekwondo Tournament 2026 Namangan**

3. INTERNATIONAL REFEREES

A. The required number of International Referees shall be determined in accordance with the WT Rules.

B. Round-trip airfare shall be the responsibility of each participating International Referee, while the Organizing Committee will cover accommodation, meals, and local transportation from **October 26-30 2026**.

A. The Organizing Committee will provide a per diem of **US\$150 per day** to participating referees for each competition day from **27–30 October 2026**

2. REGISTRATION

A. Deadline: 20 October 2026 (12:00 AM Uzbekistan Standard Time)

- During the correction period, all teams must verify the accuracy of their registration details, including the list of participating athletes, divisions, and weight categories.
- No changes or corrections will be accepted after the correction period. Any issues resulting from failure to check or confirm the registration information shall be the responsibility of the respective team and not the Organizing Committee.

HEAD OF TEAM MEETING

Date: 27 October 2026 **Venue:** Hotel “Akhsikent”

A. The Head of Team Meeting and the drawing of lots will be conducted on the day before the **Uzbekistan Open G1**. The drawing of lots will be carried out from **-54kg to +87kg** according to the alphabetical order of the official English names of the

participating countries, in the presence of team delegates and officials.

B. For nations whose delegates do not attend the Head of Team Meeting, the Supervisor of the Drawing of Lots will conduct the drawing on their behalf.

C. The order of the drawing of lots is subject to change upon the decision made at the Head of Team Meeting.

COACH ELIGIBILITY

A. The minimum age requirement for coaches is **18 years old**.

B. Coaches must hold a valid **WT Coach Certificate Level 1 or above**.

C. Coaches must possess a valid **2026 WT Global Official License**.

D. All coaches are required to wear formal attire, including a **tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short sleeves), trousers, and sports shoes** during the **Semi-Finals and Finals**.

INDEMNITY

A. The Organizing Committee will provide accident insurance coverage for all competitors **during the competition period only**.

B. Only first-aid treatment will be provided for injuries sustained during the competition.

PARTICIPATION SUPPORT

A. Ground Transportation: The Organizing Committee (O.C.) will provide ground transportation between the airport and official hotels.

- **Arrival:** 26–28 October 2026
- **Departure:** 30 October 2026
- The Organizing Committee will also provide shuttle bus services between official accommodations and the competition venue during the Championships.
- Except for participants who arrange their travel through other travel agencies or regional organizations

- A.** All competitors must wear **WT-approved Taekwondo equipment**.
- B.** All registration procedures, including accommodation arrangements, must be completed before the competition by **20 October 2026**.
- C.** Any matters not specified in these regulations shall be handled in accordance with the **WT Competition Rules & Interpretation** and in consultation with the **Technical Delegate** of the event.
- D.** Round-trip airfare and accommodation expenses (**room and board**) shall be the sole responsibility of the participating teams.
- E.** Any details not specified in this outline may be modified or added during the **Head of Team Meeting**.

VISA INFORMATION

Participants of the **Uzbekistan Open International Taekwondo Championships 2026** may be required to obtain a visa to enter the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The Organizing Committee (OC) can provide visa support letters within **2 working days** for any team requesting assistance. Visa support requests should be sent to:

It is the responsibility of each **Member National Association (MNA)** to check whether members of their delegation require a visa. Visa requirements can be checked through the official Uzbekistan visa information portal.

After applying for a visa to enter Uzbekistan, the MNA must send the **GWF number and biometric appointment date** of each applicant to the OC via:

The current Uzbekistan visa processing time is approximately **10 working days**. However, some countries may experience longer processing times. Therefore, athletes and accredited visitors who are expected to participate in the **Uzbekistan Open International Taekwondo Championships 2026** are strongly advised to apply for their visas as early as possible to ensure a decision is received before travel.

The OC also recommends using the **Priority Service** option, where available, for urgent visa applications requiring a decision within **5 working days**.
