Category change	Payment needed				
	After the registration deadline, if the competitor exceeds the weight				
	limit or was wrongly registered, they can change category only during				

Each category change costs 10 € and must be paid the registration table.

 \Rightarrow Once the payment is transferred, the competitor must show the proof of payment to the Martial Events representative, and they will hand the competitor a new card. The competitor is automatically registered in their new category without going to the weigh-in again. <u>Free</u>

 \Rightarrow If they are alone in their category, minors, cadets and juniors may move up to a higher weight category. Only the coach may ask for this change to the Martial Events representative.

Forbidden

 \Rightarrow On registration, on the weigh-in, on the day of the competition:

- No competitor is allowed to move up to a higher or drop down to a lower age category.
- No competitor from the C category is allowed to move up to a higher-grade category.
- No competitor from the A+B category is allowed to drop down to a lower grade category.


