Head kicks	⇒ Head kicks are NOT allowed for all Kids and C-class Cadets. ⇒ Head kicks are allowed for all AB-class cadets as well as for all juniors and seniors.	
Weigh-in	⇒ A 99-gram excess will be tolerated during weigh-in. Example : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A competitor weighing 58,0 kg will compete in the -58 kg division. - A competitor weighing 58,1 kg will compete in the -63 kg division.

5. Responsibility	
Contestants	⇒ All contestants must be in possession of their valid license and insurance ⇒ All contestants must be in possession of a valid ID card or passport. ⇒ All contestants enter the competition at their own risk. ⇒ ABFT declines any responsibility in the event of physical damage, violent behavior, injury or theft.

	<p>⇒ Foreign competitors who are underage in their country must be in possession of their signed accountability document (see attached). This document authorises underage competitors to take part in the competition and needs to be handed in during registration.</p>
Coaches	<p>⇒ Free entry for 1 coach with a maximum of 5 competitors.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 to 5 competitors: 1 coach - 6 to 10 competitors: 2 coaches - 11 to 15 competitors: 3 coaches - ... <p>⇒ 10 € fee per additional coach.</p> <p>⇒ ALL Coaches must be registered on the registration platform just like the athletes</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must wear sporting attire (No Dobok).</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must be at least 18 years old.</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their ID card or passport.</p> <p>⇒ All BTF-affiliated (ABFT-TVDSG-VTB) coaches must be in possession of their Coach card.</p> <p>⇒ Coaches must be in possession of their valid license/insurance.</p>
First Aid	A Red Cross team will be in attendance throughout the competition.
Protectors	<p>⇒ WT-approved protectors are mandatory for all categories (head protector, mouthguard, forearm protectors, shin protectors, groin guard, foot protectors), including categories where head kicks are not allowed.</p> <p>⇒ Face protectors is authorized but not mandatory for all Kids and Cadets.</p> <p>⇒ Face protector is not allowed for all Juniors and Seniors.</p>
Protests	<p>Challenges to a referee's decision can only be made by the Head Coach immediately after the end of a match. The coach will need to fill out the appropriate form provided by the organizer. Each challenge will be subject to a 100€ fee. The fee will be reimbursed if the challenge is granted to the coach. The Referee Chairman's decision will be the only one deemed as valid. Organiser's responsibility	<p>⇒The organiser cannot be deemed responsible if a contestant is alone in their weight category.</p> <p>⇒Friendly matches will be held only if the competition timing allows it.</p> <p>⇒No refunds will be made.</p>

Individual awards	<p>The 1st, 2nd and 3rd of each category will be awarded with a gold, silver and bronze medal respectively.</p> <p>Medals will be awarded at the end of each fight.</p> <p>Three trophies will be awarded:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fair-play trophy (club) - Best referee trophy - Best fighter trophy
Team awards	<p>A trophy will be awarded to the top 3 teams.</p> <p>Team rankings will be determined in accordance with the WT competition Rules.</p>
