Please note, all payments are non-refundable once they have been processed. In the event of not reaching a minimum of 150 entries at the time of payment deadline, the organiser reserves the right to cancel the event. All entries will be refunded minus a 10 % processing fee.

4. Method of Competition

Competition will be held under the most current **World Taekwondo Poomsae rules & interpretations** as in force as of May 14th, 2019, amended for Online Competitions in 2020 and Para Poomsae Rules as of Jan 1st, 2017, and will be run on a **Cut Off System** of up to 3 rounds (Preliminary, Semi-final and Final) for all categories.

5. Classifications of Competition

Age Limits

The age limits for each division (excluding Family Poomsae which is not age limited) is based on the year, not on the date when the competition is held.

All athletes in Recognized Poomsae must show **two different Poomsae each round**.

Nevertheless, in Class C athletes may show Poomsae which they performed in a previous round. **Class A** must show those Poomsae in order selected by the **Poomsae draw** and being published. **Class B and C** may choose within the given Poomsae range.

For Cadet Pairs they can mix with members from a higher age group (i.e., one Cadet, one Junior). The compulsory Poomsae for this combination Pair is chosen from the highest member in age from that Pair (i.e., Junior).

All athletes in Recognized Poomsae must show **two different Poomsae each round**.

Nevertheless, in Class C athletes may show Poomsae which they performed in a previous round. **Class A** must show those Poomsae in order selected by the **Poomsae draw** and being published. **Class B and C** may choose within the given Poomsae range.

For Cadet Teams they can mix with one member of a higher age group (i.e., two Cadets, one Junior). The compulsory Poomsae for this combined Team is chosen from the highest member of age from that Team (i.e., Junior).

B. Para Poomsae

Para Categories will be split as per World Taekwondo rules and regulations and will also be separated into Male / Female and Kup / Dan Grades.

The Poomsae may be chosen free - 2 Poomsae each round, preferably in one video.

P40 – Limb Deficiency (**Competitor's choice of Poomsae**)

P50 – Wheelchair Classes (Competitor's choice of Poomsae)

P60 – Deaf (Competitor's choice of Poomsae)

P71/P72 - Short Stature (Competitor's choice of Poomsae)

C. Family Poomsae

One parent, parents, or grandparents together with their child or children or grandchildren. The number of family members is unlimited. **At least two generations are required for a family team.** There is no age limit or graduation restriction for Family Poomsae. Family Poomsae has Finals only.

The Recognized Poomsae can be freely selected – two Poomsae.

Freestyle competition has 1 Poomsae per round and Finals only.

5. Uniforms

Poomsae competition uniform: All contestants *may* wear WT-approved Poomsae competition uniform. If contestants do not have a WT-approved Poomsae competition uniform, contestants are able to wear any World Taekwondo uniform (in white colour or gold for Grandmaster). Besides the Taekwondo uniform – dobok and belt – nothing else is allowed: no shoes, no socks, no jewellery etc.

Any kind of religious related stuff must be declared and approved by the organizing committee. We kindly ask to keep those things to a minimum.

Any medical related braces etc. must be declared and approved by the organizing committee.

Any visible things other than dobok and belt or mentioned in World Taekwondo Poomsae Competition rules will lead to deductions in the competitor's score(s).

6. Methods of Competition

6.1 Cut-off-System


Preliminary: Only categories of 20 and more players will have a Preliminary round, competitors should take maximum 30 seconds break before performing the next Poomsae. Top 50 % of competitors will progress to the Semi-finals round.

Semi-Finals: Categories of less than 20 players will go straight to the Semi-finals round. Competitors should take maximum 30 seconds break before performing the next Poomsae. The top 8 competitors will progress to the Final round.

Final: Dan categories of 9 competitors or less will go straight to Finals (Kup Grades 10 or less will go straight to the Finals). Competitors should take maximum 30 seconds break before performing the next Poomsae. The top 3 will receive a medal depending on their finishing position. Family Poomsae has Finals only.

6.2 Specific rules for online video competition

Competitors should start their Poomsae facing the camera whilst performing the necessary Poomsae stances to prepare and begin Poomsae: enter, then Chariot (attention stance), Kyongye (bow), Joonbi (ready stance) and then perform their Poomsae. Once finished they should return to Joonbi stance (facing camera at the end) and then bow before resting for 30 seconds to perform next Poomsae or finish the recording after the second Compulsory Poomsae. Competitor must stay within the camera view during the break between the Poomsae's. The competitor may drink, stretch, walk around during the break between the Poomsae's. During the performance, the competitor's full body head to toe must be in camera view and 0.3 deduction will be given if any part of the body goes out of view each movement. See illustration below as a set up guideline:



Competitors are encouraged to display their country's national flag (or name of country) behind the competitor's competition area in clear view of the camera. They can also add their official NOC flag (IOC recognized) by video editing.

Competitors can wear a dobok with the IOC recognized NOC code or club name on the back, according to World Taekwondo competition rules.

Competitors must not wear any kind of shoes, socks or anything not mentioned in the World Taekwondo Poomsae rules. Also, jewellery must be taken of or hidden.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic we allow competitors to wear masks during their performance. Nevertheless, the eyes must be visible still.

Competitors whole body must always be visible during the performance video footage, for fair and proper competition judging to be carried out according to the Poomsae competition rules set in place. Videos which do not meet these standards may be removed from competition.

It is not mandatory to perform the Poomsae on mats. The competitor can choose his/her surroundings and surfaces if during recording the whole body is always visible. For example, one can record in a room, in a hotel lobby or on a grass field, even on a street.

If your video has been edited, it will be rejected, except for adding graphics to display your national flag and your name. Prohibited editing may lead to disqualification, even after the competition has ended.

Videos must not be re-used from previous competitions or other events! In case OC encounters re-used videos, the competitor(s) may be disqualified, even after competition has ended.

Videos must be set as <u>visible to all</u>. We urge competitors to upload well in advance as to not run into technical upload difficulties hours before the deadline entry. The upload platform of our choice is YouTube and all videos to be scored must be set to 'unlisted' or 'open' status, otherwise the Judges will disqualify the competitor(s).

It is not allowed to show any religious, political, or any other symbols negatively targeting a group or an individual in the video recording. Videos not following this rule are subject to immediate rejection.

6.3 Livestream

Competition will be livestreamed through our YouTube channels during event days:

Competition schedule is approximate and may be subject to change by the organizing committee. Please follow our <u>Facebook page</u> for the latest updates.

7. JUDGES & OFFICIALS

Poomsae performances submitted will be judged and scored by qualified top International Referees (IR) only over the course of all competition days in which the virtual championships are held to ensure the carrying out of fair and quality competition scoring in accordance with the most up-to-date official World Taekwondo Poomsae competition rules.

8. PROCEDURE OF PROTEST

Only the official head coach can protest to the Competition Director. This must be made within 15 minutes of the end of the contest in written form to the organizer's e-mail. A protest fee of 100 Euro will be payable immediately to the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won.

9. SITUATIONS NOT COVERED BY THE RULES

Where any situation arises, which is not covered by these rules, it shall be dealt with and decision given by the Referees after consultation with the organizing committee and the Competition Supervisory Board.

10. AWARDS

Virtual participation certificate and medals winner certificate will be awarded to the top 4 scoring competitors from each category.

1st place: will be awarded a Gold Medal Certificate.

2nd place: will be awarded a Silver Medal Certificate.

3rd place: will be awarded a Bronze Medal Certificate.

All other participants may request a **Participation certificate** sent by e-mail.

A physical medal is available for all top 3 competitors. Coaches will receive the option for their athletes to opt in on this medal till one week after the competition by our online form. By opting in the coach accepts to pay for the postal service cost for sending out the medal(s) to his/her club or personal adress. The organisation will inform the coach of the total postage cost for their team. In the family competition, only one medal is awarded to each medal winning family. Additional medals may be requested by the coach at own cost.
