Coach	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Free entrance for one coach per team of 5 athletes. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - From 1 to 5 : 1 coach - From 6 to 10 : 2 coaches - From 11 to 15 : 3 coaches - ... ⇒ Each added coach costs 10 €.
Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ The organiser is not responsible if the athlete is the only one in their category. ⇒ No refund allowed.
Spectators	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ 10 € / person (you can pay by card or cash) ⇒ Free for children under 6 years old.
Weigh-in	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Each competitor must give their license when weighing.
	<p><u>Seniors</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Senior competitors must come alone to the weigh-in. ⇒ A competitor's weight can exceed the limit by 99g. <p><i>E.g. :</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>A competitor with a weight of 58,0 kg can compete in the -58 kg category.</i> - <i>A competitor with a weight of 58,1 kg must compete in the -63 kg category.</i>
	<p><u>Pupils, minors, cadets and juniors</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Coaches may accompany pupils, minors, cadets and juniors during the weigh-in. ⇒ Since they cannot be weighted naked, pupils, minors, cadets and juniors may exceed the limit by 199g.
Category change	<p><u>Payment needed</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ After the registration deadline, if the competitor exceeds the weight limit or was wrongly registered, they can change category only during the official weigh-in and a payment is needed.

Each category change costs 10 € and must be paid the registration and weigh-in table.

⇒ Once the payment is transferred, the competitor must show the proof of payment to the Martial Events representative (**the club representative will add a stamp on the competitor's card once the change is paid**), and they will hand the competitor a new card. The competitor is automatically registered in their new category without going to the weigh-in again.

Free

⇒ If they are alone in their category, minors, cadets and juniors may move up to a higher weight category. Only the coach may ask for this change to the Martial Events representative.

Forbidden

⇒ On registration, on the weigh-in, on the day of the competition:

- No competitor is allowed to move up to a higher or drop down to a lower age category.
- No competitor from the C category is allowed to move up to a higher-grade category.
- No competitor from the A+B category is allowed to drop down to a lower grade category.

Electronical trunks	<p>⇒ « Daedo » GEN 3 electronical trunks will be used throughout the competitions for all the categories and electronical head gears for the categories that require them.</p> <p>⇒ Each competitor must have their own Daedo sensor socks.</p> <p>⇒ Competitors who cannot hit the head must have their own head gear.</p>
Referee	International (IR-WT) and national referees
Prizes	<p>⇒ The 1st, 2nd and 3rd of each category will receive a gold, silver and bronze medal respectively.</p> <p>⇒ Medals are handed in at the end of the fight.</p> <p>⇒ There will be three cups handed at the end of the competition:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fair-play cup • To the best referee cup • To the best competitor: in women category and in men category
Team prizes	<p>⇒ There will be a cup for the five first teams in the ranking.</p> <p>⇒ For the final team ranking, the points will be given according to the WT competition rules.</p>
Contestations	<p>Only the main coach can make a complaint immediately after the fight. The coach will fill in a form given by the organiser. 100€ will be paid for each complaint. INSURANCE AND SAFETY

Competitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ Each competitor must have their VALID insurance-license.⇒ Each competitor must have their ID card or passport.⇒ Each competitor enters the competition at their own risk.⇒ The ABFT and the organiser aren't responsible for physical damages, violence acts, injuries and thefts.
Head kicks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ hitting the head is forbidden for all C-category minors and cadets.⇒ Hitting the head is allowed only from AB-category cadets and for all juniors and seniors.
Coach	<ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ Coach must be over 18.⇒ they must wear sportswear clothes.⇒ They must have their ID card or passport.⇒ Coaches from a club member of a federation affiliated to the BTF (ABFT – TKDV – TVDSG) must have their WT or national coach card.⇒ Coach must have a VALID insurance-license.
Protections	<ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ All protections mentionned in the WT rules are compulsory for all categories (head gear, mouthguard, forearm protection, gloves, shinbone protection, box and sensor socks), even for the categories that cannot hit the head.⇒ The visor is allowed for minors and cadets, but not compulsory.
First aid	There will be a doctor on site throughout the competition.
