Instruction for video submission process

This guide will explain how to record your videos and how to submit them for the event through the Martial. Events online registration platform. Deadline for submitting videos is **Sunday 1**st of **August**, **15.00 EDT Time**.

Record your videos

- Record two (2) poomsaes within one (1) video each round
- Record videos according to regulations within the <u>information package</u>
- Setup your own YouTube channel

- Upload the videos to your YouTube channel

Your uploaded videos on YouTube should contain the following information in the order requested:

- a. Competition round (Preliminary, Semi-Final, Final)
- b. Competitor's First Name and Surname
- c. Category
- d. Sex (M for Male, F for Female)
- e. Nationality in a short format (GBR instead of Great Britain)
- f. Virtual Range Open Poomsae Championships 2021 (TRO2021)

Example: Semi-Final - Aaron Leith - Dan U30 M - GBR - TRO2021

Only use Latin characters (A - Z) above. Using other formats may result in disqualification.

• Make sure the videos are set to "public" regarding visibility




Submit your videos

Step 1) Go to your registration page


- Go to https://www.martial.events/en/events/toronto-range-online-first-edition

- Click on "Go to Registration" with the club you've made your registration






Step 2) Provide YouTube links

• Click on "Details" for the entry you wish to add the YouTube links




• Click on "Edit entry"



Paste your YouTube links into the boxes

Depending on the category, you will have to submit a preliminary round video, a semi-final video and/or final video. For example: K2 and K3 will have no field for "Semi-Final", because only the preliminary round and final applies.
